Founded in 1991, the association aims to increase the attractiveness of STEM professions for women, to represent the interests of STEM women in public, to provide a platform for the exchange of experiences and networking, and to attract more young women to STEM

professions. Today, the SVIN comprises more than 310 women engineers, computer scientists, physicists, mathematicians as well as natural scientists (STEM women) and 43 supporting members, all medium to large companies as well as associations and universities that rely on the work of women engineers and women from the STEM fields.



As a professional association, the SVIN sees itself as a representative of the interests of qualified and motivated women professionals in the STEM fields.

What we do

- Illustrate the attractiveness of STEM professions; convey modern role models and thus motivate young women for STEM professions (promotion of young talent),
- Promote and maintain the exchange of experience and cooperation among SVIN women and with related organisations (network building),
- Together with supporting members, improve the working and general conditions for STEM women and create added value for companies thanks to diversity and inclusion measurements (gender-equal career promotion).

What we offer our members


Individual members of SVIN have access to a wide range of offers such as:
